# HOME VISIT X

Home Visit X is a performance you can put in your hand luggage - big ideas are rarely presented so intimately.

In a private living room, 15 people become part of a production that interweaves personal stories and the mechanisms of political national identity. How much of that is in one person? The abstract national idea is contrasted with the individuality of a private home.



**Stage dimensions** taking place in private homes

**Visitors per show** 15

**Shows per day possible** 2 with one team, 4 with two teams

**Duration** 120 min

**Rehearsal period Europe** 4-5 days including try-outs for the local team

**Rehearsal period World** 6-8 days including try-outs for the local team

**Rimini crew travelling** 1 director, 1 MC, 1 technician for set-up. Shows only with local team.

**Local crew needed** 1 production manager, 1 local MC, 1 local assistant, 1 local technician, 1 translator

„What sets up this play fits in an Aldi bag – the real play however is the social situation itself, which emerges from a few rules of the game, props and the four walls of a host. Here, we dive into the world of another person and the behaviour of a group which neither sees nor consumes the play but creates it by means of answers and actions.“
